_ga	Google Analytics, domain host and ID	2 years
_gat	Google Analytics, URL page capture for analysis	1 minute
_gd*	Google Analytics, used for statistical analysis	24 hours
_gid	Google Analytics, unique id distinguisher	24 hours
NID	Google set a number of cookies on any page that includes a Google Map or use their geo-location services.	6 months
__utma	Google Analytics, used to throttle request rate	10 minutes
__utmb	Google Analytics, used to determine new sessions/visits. The cookie is created when the JavaScript library executes and no existing __utmb cookies exists. The cookie is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.	30 minutes
__utmc	Google Analytics, operated in conjunction with the __utmb cookie to determine whether the user is in a new session/visit.	6 months
__utmt	Google Analytics, used to throttle request rate.	6 months
__utmz	Google Analytics, Stores the traffic source or campaign that explains how the user reached your site. The cookie is created when the JavaScript library executes and is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.	6 months
_redmine_session	Redmine sets a session id if a support ticket is raised and submitted to us.	6 months
CONSENT	Google consent cookie	6 months
lang	twitter cookie to set language when using Twitter Widget on page.	Session duration
wordfence_verifiedHuman	Cookie set by the Wordfence Security WordPress plugin to protect the site against malicious attacks	24 hours
